MEETING MINUTES**

I Call to Order: Mike Hager, President, called the meeting to order at 12:14 p.m.

II Secretary Report: Lynze Moon reviewed the January 26, 2008 minutes. Tiffany Payne made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Sawyer Broshar. Motion passed and the minutes were approved.

The ending balance to date was \$6,872.45. Zach Beck made a motion to approve the Treasure's Report, seconded by Brittney Kincaid. Motion passed and the report was approved.

Jackie Kincaid gave Sawyer a check from the silent auction that needs to be deposited. Sherry Gramenz informed the youth club that the adult club does reimburse some amount of the Yearly Youth Membership Dues and that they also need to reimburse \$1005.00 for the 2007 back numbers.

IV New Business:

1) Fundraising:

- Sherry Gramenz explained how the **Home Interior Candle Sales** would be successful. Half of the purchase price of the candle would go to the youth club. Payment is due at the time of order. Julie Broshar said that this has been an awesome fundraiser in the past for other clubs. Sherry is going to contact the Home Interior consultant to have packets available for mailing. Tiffany Payne is going to mail out the fundraiser information packets to the all youth members. Items are to be sold throughout the month of April and all orders will be due on Sunday, May 11, 2008. The youth club is going to purchase some extra candles to have available for sale through the Tack Room.

Mike Hager made a motion to implement the Home Interiors fundraising project as discussed, seconded by Lynze Moon. Motion passed.

- **Subway Dinner**, Friday night at the IPHC Memorial Weekend show being held in Cedar Rapids at Kirkwood Equine Center. The dinner would operate from 5 p.m. till food is gone. The sandwiches have been donated by

Subway, bags of chips will be purchased by the youth club funds, sodas we will try to get them donated, and the desserts will all be donated by the youth families. If anyone has any suggestions on how to or where to find a way to have the sodas donated, please let one of the Advisors or President, Mike Hager, know as soon as possible. Just like last year, we would like to have the youth families donate some type of dessert. The meal will cost: \$5.00 The youth members need to make signs advertising the fund raiser to be posted throughout Kirkwood Equine Center.

Some ideas to help with this event include: asking the IPHC Board to sponsor or help pay for the food, or try to have food donated, Brandie to contact Carlos O' Kelly's for prices, and to have someone contact Deb Ketelson to ask if we could use some of her fun party beach theme items. The youth members need to make signs advertising the event to be posted throughout Kirkwood Equine Center.

Mike Hager made a motion to implement the "Welcome, Met the Youth~ Party" Framed Print raffle as discussed, seconded by Lynze Moon. Motion passed.

- Extreme trail class was discussed. This would be a fundraiser/entry fee, all-age class that would include riders to have a "theme" naming the horse/rider and dressed in costume and then do a bid (Cal-Cutta) on who is going to win. Ideas and suggestions were mentioned.
