Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin will be pointing this show for their year-end awards to entice their members to come to this show in Iowa. Tawny moved to have the joint show with Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. Jerry seconded. Motion carried.
 - APHA Zone 5 Show, April 23 & 24
 - Cindy moved to approve this show for points only (judges not counting) and Tawny seconded. Motion approved.
- We have hired Nicole Moss and Lindsey Pinkham-Heiden for the 3 shows this year as ring stewards. They are both from Nebraska so we'll have to pay more in mileage, but they will carpool and share a room.

• Show rules – year end awards: We need to consider how many shows/weekends should be required to qualify for year-end awards.
